Basic Covid-19 Prevention Protocols for In-Person Worship in the Sanctuary

Drafted on April 28, 2021, based on ACC's more extensive Covid-19 Prevention Plan.

Please note that some of these restrictions will be relaxed for future worships, as the public health situation and our comfort levels improve.

- 1. Registration in advance required to attend. Hosts will ensure access is limited to those who have registered.
- 2. Proof of vaccination required for all adults, including 2 weeks' post-immunization period. (Once ACC has your vaccination card on file, you don't need to re-send it.)
- 3. Temperature check required, before entering.
- 4. Masks required throughout worship.
- 5. Ventilation will be maximized via open doors and fans.
- 6. Sanctuary will be at 25% or less occupancy (this includes over 60 worshippers).
- 7. Individuals will be seated at least six feet apart from one another (except couples, or others in the same "bubble").
- 8. No group singing. Music will be instrumental, or perhaps soloists singing at a safe distance.
- 9. No personal contact, including handshakes and hugs.
- 10. Designated entry and exit doors and aisles, to assure one-way traffic.
- 11. Worship time will be less than 50 minutes.
- 12. No social hour. When worship concludes, we say goodbye and exit promptly.
